### Communication

### **Promote**

They have just earned a lot of skills with helping in your unit, it would be a shame to lose them now. Encourage them to stay within Girlguiding and/or join the Student Scout and Guide Organisation at their university (if available, see www.ssago.org).



### Social media

There are lots of groups on social media, namely 'Girlguiding - movers' on Facebook, that are great for this situation. Putting a post that you have a helper leaving to go to a certain university (or even advertising that you are a unit in a university town) can go a long way.



### Communication

Try emailing the region, county or district that they are moving to ahead of time, which helps local volunteers plan and be ready for communication from leavers.

## Freshers' fairs

If you are a university town, there are lots of things you can do to promote your unit. Freshers' fairs are held at the universities to promote student activities. Why not attend with your unit or speak to you commissioner about attending as a district, division or county?



### No pressure

This can be a very stressful time for them, but volunteering can add familiarity at a time of great change. However, university comes first, so appreciate that they may not be able to attend all meetings as their timetable may conflict and the university term times can be different to school times.
